Calls for Service

March showed a slight dip in overall calls for service. Most of this is due to a drop in the number of part-time hours this month. We ran 93 calls for service, which is 1 more than March 2018 and up over 2017. Our traffic calls went from 52% from 33 to 16 while criminal calls and general calls remained even with last year. Our service calls increased 233% from last year, mostly due to our continued presence at the schools.

Year to date we are still up over previous years. We are at 338 calls this year up 33% from 254 last year and 227 in 2017. Year to date our traffic calls are down 35% from 89 last year to 58 this year. Our criminal have a 36% increase from 22 to 30 and general are up 10% from 68 to 75 this year so far. Our two biggest areas of increase are in ordinance calls (up 132% from last year's 31 to 41 this year and up 227% from 18 in 2017) and service calls (up 305% from 44 last year to 134 this year).

The Dunn County Sheriff's Office addressed an additional 15 calls for service in the village while our officers were not available. We also responded to 9 request for mutual aid outside of the village.

We issued 6 traffic citations and 1 ordinance citation to municipal court. We made four misdemeanor arrests and one felony arrest on a child abuse case from last year. We spent quite a bit of time conducting follow up investigations which required several search warrants and records subpoenas and reviewing a lot of digital evidence. We attended the sentencing for Ted Lopez as he was sentenced to decades in prison for his abuse of several children in our community and are glad he has been held accountable.

Budget

We are a quarter of the way through the budget year and are only 21% through our budget. The new CAD/RMS software is still developing as we meet weekly to implement it. As we learn its functionality, we are finding new ways that it will help our staff in our daily duties.

Other Activities

The new emergency management plan has been filed with the county. CSO Traxler continues to monitor ordinance violations as things continue to thaw out in addition to working with residents obtaining their building permits.

Sgt. Rud completed the background investigation on Officer Kurtzhals and we expect him to start in the next week. This will help us provide more staff hours and coverage.

We learned that we have been awarded a \$4000 grant to purchase three new Automatic External Defibrillators. We will place one in each squad car and another at Village Hall. These life-saving tools will be available to the officers and the community at large when they use the community center. Once we obtain the equipment, we will work with the ambulance district to get training for our staff to use these devices.

We've organized another drug take back event on Saturday April 27 at Village Hall and have received grant funding to cover our expenses. We will be working with a new youth group at this event. We've also worked with the schools and the fire and ambulance districts to organize a mock car crash the week before prom. We also will be hosting a mock drug room for parents to help educate them.



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We participated in the county safe schools meeting and have been meeting with school officials as we continue to figure out sustainable options for a SRO program.
